- 1. abravīt अववीत् [verb; past tense; third person singular] (4.1) said; spoke; taught
- 2. abhyutthānam अभ्युत्थानम् [noun; gender: neuter] (4.7) rise; increase
- 3. ādau आदौ [noun-locative; gender: masculine] (4.4) at first; in the beginning; initially
- 4. apare अपरे [pronoun; gender: masculine; plural] (4.25, 4.27, 4.28 4.30) others
- 5. arpaṇam अप्णम् [noun; masculine] (4.24) offering; that with which offerings are made in a sacrifice or yajña
- 6. bahūni बहुनि [noun; gender: neuter; plural] (4.5) many
- 7. buddhimān बुद्धिमान् [noun; gender: masculine] (4.18) one who is endowed with intelligence; an intelligent person
- 8. dharmasya धर्मस्य [noun-genitive; gender: masculine] (4.7) of righteousness
- 9. divyam दिव्यम् [noun-accusative; gender: neuter] (4.9) divine, celestial
- 10. gahanā শহনা [noun; gender: feminine] (4.17) imponderable; hard to be understood
- 11. glāniḥ ग्लानिः [noun; gender: feminine] (4.7) decay; decline
